The serious crisis that humanity is going through because of Covid-19 has taken on new and more radical meanings than the pandemics or other major natural disasters of which we have historical memory. The social impact of Covid-19's extraordinary contagion force and tragic death effects has been very strong.

The recognized need to have to appeal above all to new scientific knowledge in order to stem the tragic pandemic, have made us feel and grasp a more widespread awareness of the importance of scientific knowledge, but also of the precariousness of human existence; the deceitfulness of many scales of shared values and the impossibility of finding the solution to every problem with available technological devices, but also capable, by changing their use, of reducing the negative effect of the lock down on school and university learning, allowing you to practice online training.

These and other effects of the pandemic, now the subject of many investigations, pose questions to which to give reliable, albeit interlocutory, answers.

The conference aims to carry out a critical analysis of some issues that emerged from this tragic pandemic experience, and others that will be highlighted thanks to cognitive investigations attributable to the qualification of education and training processes. For example, starting from some simple questions, of the type mentioned below:

- Technological solutions for remote operation can make it possible even more than operating in presence the facilitation of the achievement of those cultural results traditionally «reserved», only for the best students?
- FaD can also contribute to traditional teaching, in presence, high qualification elements?
- Politics are really invested as never before to promote conditions of a closer and more fruitful mutual cooperation between human sciences, nature and technology to answer many of the problems that have emerged with this pandemic?
- Networking of «video lessons» to replace «face to face lessons», e in the download of study materials, how does it differ from the FaD?
- How the Training is designed, organized and implemented with cultural success Remote?
- What are the qualitative and quantitative effects on the cognitive, emotional and relational level of students who are not in possession of particular technological devices in FaD experiences?
- Why and how to bend modern technologies to the results of the most advanced and accredited empirical-experimental, theoretical and applicative research on cognitive, emotional and dynamic-relational and social

development in different age groups? And what effects on such development and attitudes. do the self-assessment processes in FaD produce?

- In addition to the countries, has Covid-19 also produced an asymmetric shock among students, categories and socio-cultural classes?
