Co-authors may sign different copies of the statement and send them to the Corresponding Author or to the Editor of the volume.

1. The undersigned Authors of the above mentioned work hereby

a) they declare that

- (in the case of journals) adheres/adhere to the ethical standards published in the Journal website
- the work is of their exclusive property and does not contain anything which infringes any third party's copyright or other rights
- the work is submitted in final form such that excluding any correction or change in proof
- if any of the content of the work is copyrighted to a third party, copy of the written permission from such other party granting LED the right to use the material in both print and online formats is submitted along with this statement (n. _____ attachments); they shall indemnify and hold harmless the Publisher against all actions, proceedings and claims and against all costs, demands and expenses (including legal expenses) arising from unauthorized reproductions.

b) they authorize LED to publish the work (if accepted)

- in print form under the "LED Edizioni Universitarie di Lettere Economia Diritto" trademark
- (at the discretion of the editors of the volume / series / journal):

c) they agree and accept the following paragraphs 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10.

2. Figures can be reproduced only if they are free of copyright restrictions, i.e. if they are in the public domain or accompanied by permission from the rights holder. Images downloaded from the Internet always require authorization unless expressly declared otherwise in the source. Authors must identify all materials and figures which require authorization for publication and provide the permission on submission of the work to be published. No work with copyright permissions pending will be accepted. The sources of figures and tables reproduced from other publications must be cited.

3. The publication, both in print and online, does not imply any transfer of copyright by the Authors to the Publisher. The copyright of the content is maintained wholly by the respective Authors. The editorial format and the graphical layout of the works published in print and/or online by LED remain the exclusive property of LED.

4. Authors authorize the publication of articles in journals under a Creative Commons "Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives 4.0 International (CC BY-NC-ND)" license. This license prohibits the use of published materials for commercial means or within a commercial context.

For this reason, and in order not to detract from the journal's statistics, it is prohibited to upload the finalized files to a website that includes advertising and/or offers consultation by payment or through a registered account (for example, social media such as "Academia", "Research Gate", and similar sites). Publication announcements on these sites must instead be accompanied by a DOI code and/or a link to the homepage of the volume or issue.

Authors are permitted to upload the complete published files only to officially-recognized institutional repositories, established and operated by universities and governments.

The finalized files of chapters published in collective volumes do not fall under the Creative Commons license, and in any case their use is permitted only within institutional archives.

5. Authors are permitted to publish their works at any time and in any form with another publisher, with the following limitations:

- the new publication must not reproduce the graphical layout of the publication which appears under the LED trademark, nor use or reproduce the PDF files published on the https://www.ledonline.it/ website, except for the institutional repositories mentioned above.
- in the new publication, references of the previous publication under the LED trademark have to be cited
- the new publication must not exclude nor limit the publication, distribution or commercial use of the work, hard copy or digital, by LED in any way.

6. LED shall have the right to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the works worldwide, even in the event that these works are re-published under another heading and/or with another publisher. To this end, LED has the right to make use of all forms of distribution, formats, media, and channels in current or future use by LED, including databases which are external to the LED website.

7. LED disclaims any liability for the possible improper use of the published works and materials by users of the web site or by third parties.

8. No fee or royalties are due to Authors.
